


To play you will need a 2 dice with pattern block shapes on the sides. The sides should be as follows: 1 hexagon, 1 trapezoid, 2 rhombuses and 2 triangles.

Each child can play individually, with a partner or a small group. Each player needs a gameboard and a small container of pattern blocks. The child rolls the 2 dice and must decide where to place the pattern blocks on the hexagon shape to fill all of them. Once the pattern blocks are laid, they can not be moved. Play continues until all of the hexagons are filled.

Extension: After filling all of the hexagons with pattern blocks, the child records his/her work using paper pattern block shapes, paper gameboard and a glue stick.
